The development cell of the college conducted several open meeting with the Headmen, leaders of the women organization. NGOs engaged in women empowerment in the remote villages of Ramgarh district, and thereby, concluded to make special arrangement to impart education (Traditional and vocational) especially the female youth who are often deprived of higher education due poor financial condition, troublesome communication transport facility, poor motivation of the family and the society as well as absence of safety and security.

Consequently the authority of the college has assured the parents and guardians to provide the following facilities-

- i. To provide scholarship, to the financially weaker section of the society
- ii. To develop a sense of security among women
- iii. Assure them for the security safety, healthy and peaceful atmosphere inside and outside college area.
- iv. The authority, the professors and the non-teaching staffs have taken a commitment to do the best and all needful to educate the girl children and thereby heading towards the women empowerment.

Impact of the practice :

- i. The girl students have started passing out regularly in their internal and external exams with the flying color which is a positive sign.
- ii. They have also started participating in games and sports, debate, seminar and cultural programmes which clearly reveal the free and safe environment of the girls in the institution.

Recourses Required

A very active and energetic role was played by the local leaders, social leaders, NGO's, women organization working in the upliftment of the overlooked segment of the society, that is women in encouraging and inspiring to get admission in the college for higher education.
